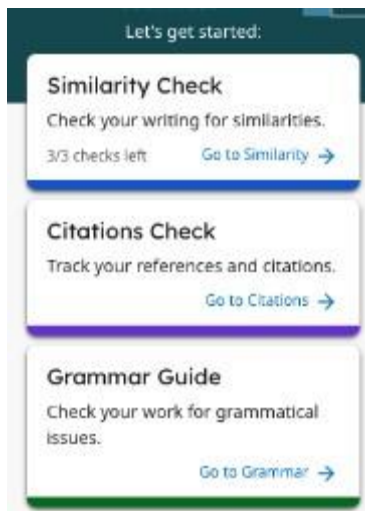

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Τι είναι το Draft Coach/Turnitin

Το Draft Coach είναι ένα εργαλείο για τους φοιτητές ως πρόσθετη εφαρμογή (add-on) με τη χρήση του [Online Microsoft 365 στο οποίο παρέχεται πρόσβαση στα μέλη του ΠΑΝΕΠΙΣΤΗΜΙΟΥ ΙΩΑΝΝΙΝΩΝ](#)

Δίνει τη δυνατότητα ελέγχου στις εργασίες των φοιτητών σε:

1. Έλεγχο λογοκλοπής (similarity check έως 3 φορές) στην αγγλική και ελληνική, οι αναφορές δεν αποθηκεύονται και είναι προσβάσιμες μόνο από το χρήστη (φοιτητή) του λογαριασμού.
2. Έλεγχο ορθότητας παραπομπών (Citations Check) δεν υπάρχει όριο στον έλεγχο.
3. Γραμματικός έλεγχος σε κείμενα στην αγγλική (Grammar Guide).



Είσοδος στην υπηρεσία

WHAT IS PLAGIARISM?

Many people think of plagiarism as copying another's work, or borrowing someone else's original ideas. But terms like "copying" and "borrowing" can disguise the seriousness of the offense.

According to the Merriam-Webster Online Dictionary, to "plagiarize" means

- to steal and pass off (the ideas or words of another) as one's own to use (another's production) without crediting the source
- to commit literary theft
- to present as new and original an idea or product derived from an existing source.

In other words, plagiarism is an act of fraud. It involves both stealing someone else's work and lying about it afterward.

Example

All of the following are considered plagiarism:

- turning in someone else's work as your own
- copying words or ideas from someone else without giving credit
- failing to put a quotation in quotation marks
- giving incorrect information about the source of a quotation
- changing words but copying the sentence structure of a source without giving credit
- copying so many words or ideas from a source that it makes up the majority of your work, whether you give credit or not (see our section on "fair use" rules)

Most cases of plagiarism can be avoided, however, by citing sources. Simply acknowledging that certain material has been borrowed, and providing your audience with the information necessary to find that source, is usually enough to prevent plagiarism.

When faculty members discover plagiarism, they may choose between simply penalizing the student themselves or reporting the plagiarism to College administrators, who will determine the penalty. Faculty members make such choices at their own discretion, depending upon the circumstances of each case. It is possible for a student to be penalized both by the faculty member and by administration. In general, the severity of the penalty matches the severity of the plagiarism.

Abstract. Recently, altmetrics have emerged as alternative means of measuring scholarly impact, aiming at improving and complementing both traditional and web-based metrics. The aim of the present study is to contribute to the altmetrics literature by providing an overview of the coverage of altmetrics sources for the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH) publications. We used Scopus to collect all research articles stating AUTH as the affiliation of at least one author and published from 2010 to 2016. The altmetric data originated from Altmetric Explorer, a service provided by Altmetric.com. Only 17% of all publications retrieved from Scopus had some kind of mentions, while there was a clear increasing trend over the years. The presence of altmetrics was different from each altmetric.com attention source. Around 81% of all mentions came from Twitter, Facebook was a distant second, followed by news outlets. All other sources had very low or negligible coverage. The overwhelming majority of tweets had been posted by members of the public, who do not link to scholarly literature. Medical Sciences had by far the highest number of publications with altmetric scores, followed in a distance by Business. However, Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences publications exhibited a significant altmetric activity. More research is needed in order to get a better insight into the altmetric landscape in Greece and develop an understanding about the kind of influence altmetrics measure, and the relationship, if any, between altmetrics indicators and scientific impact.

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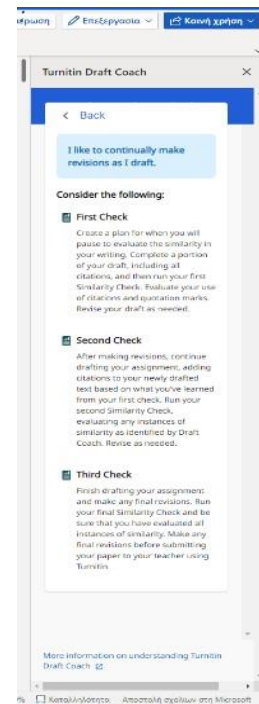
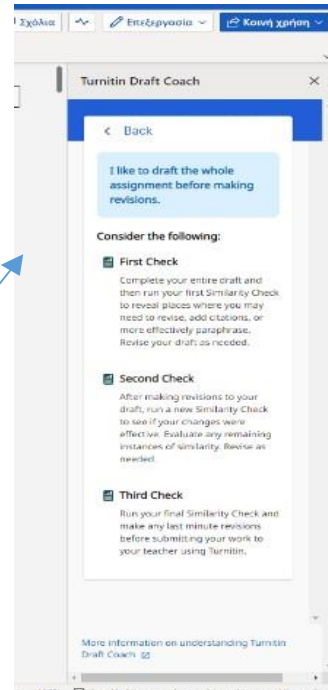

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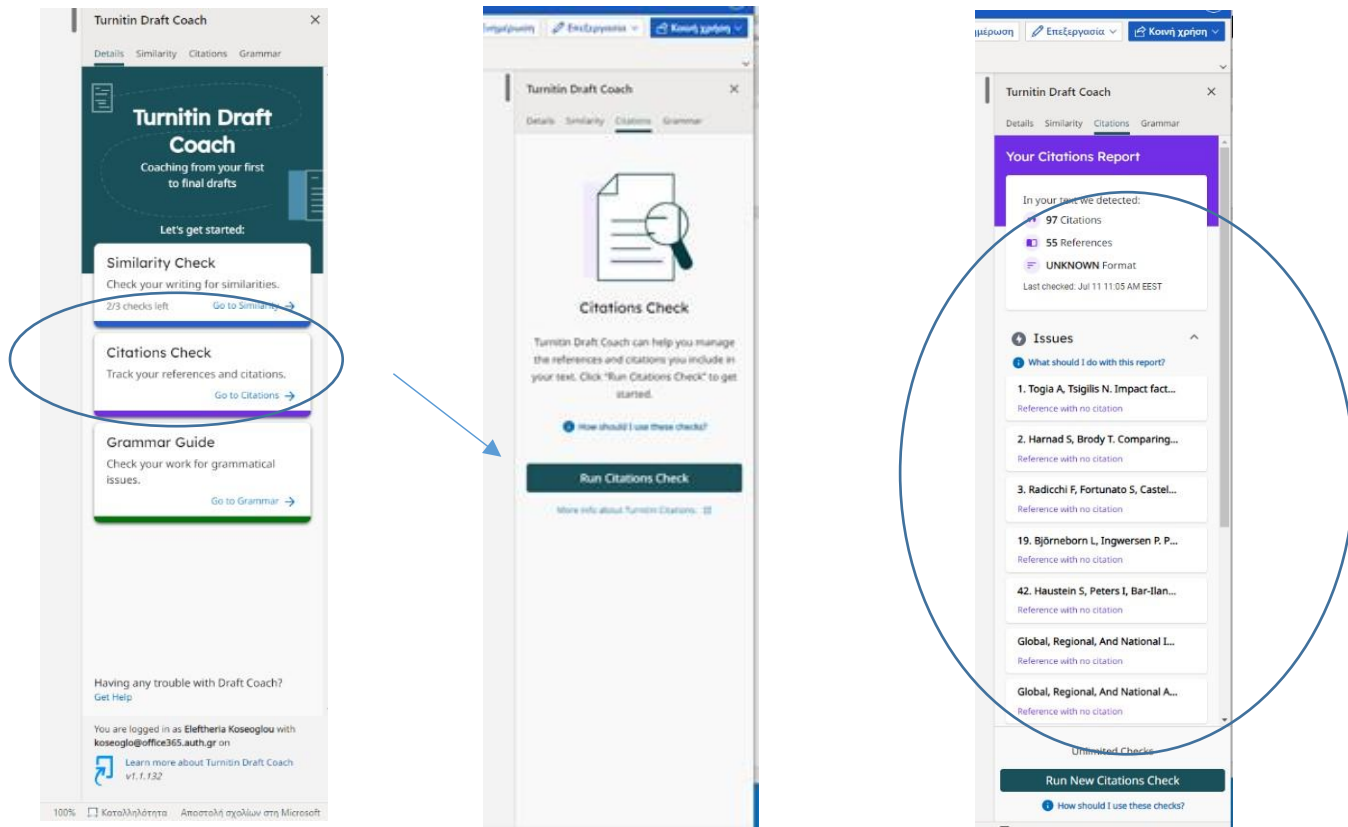
